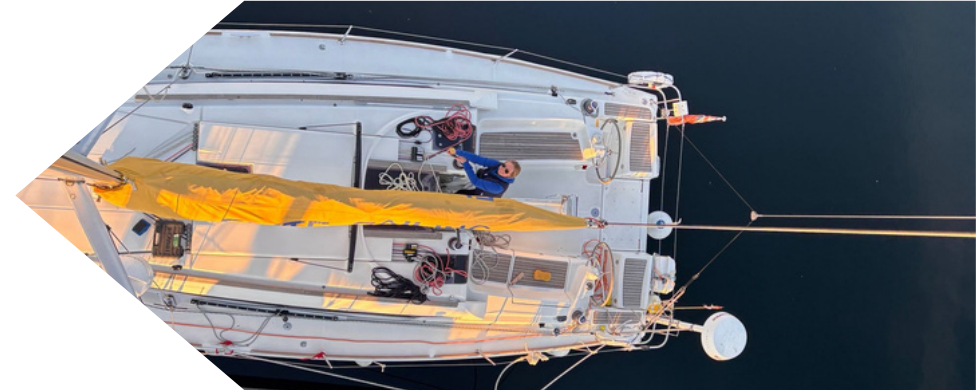

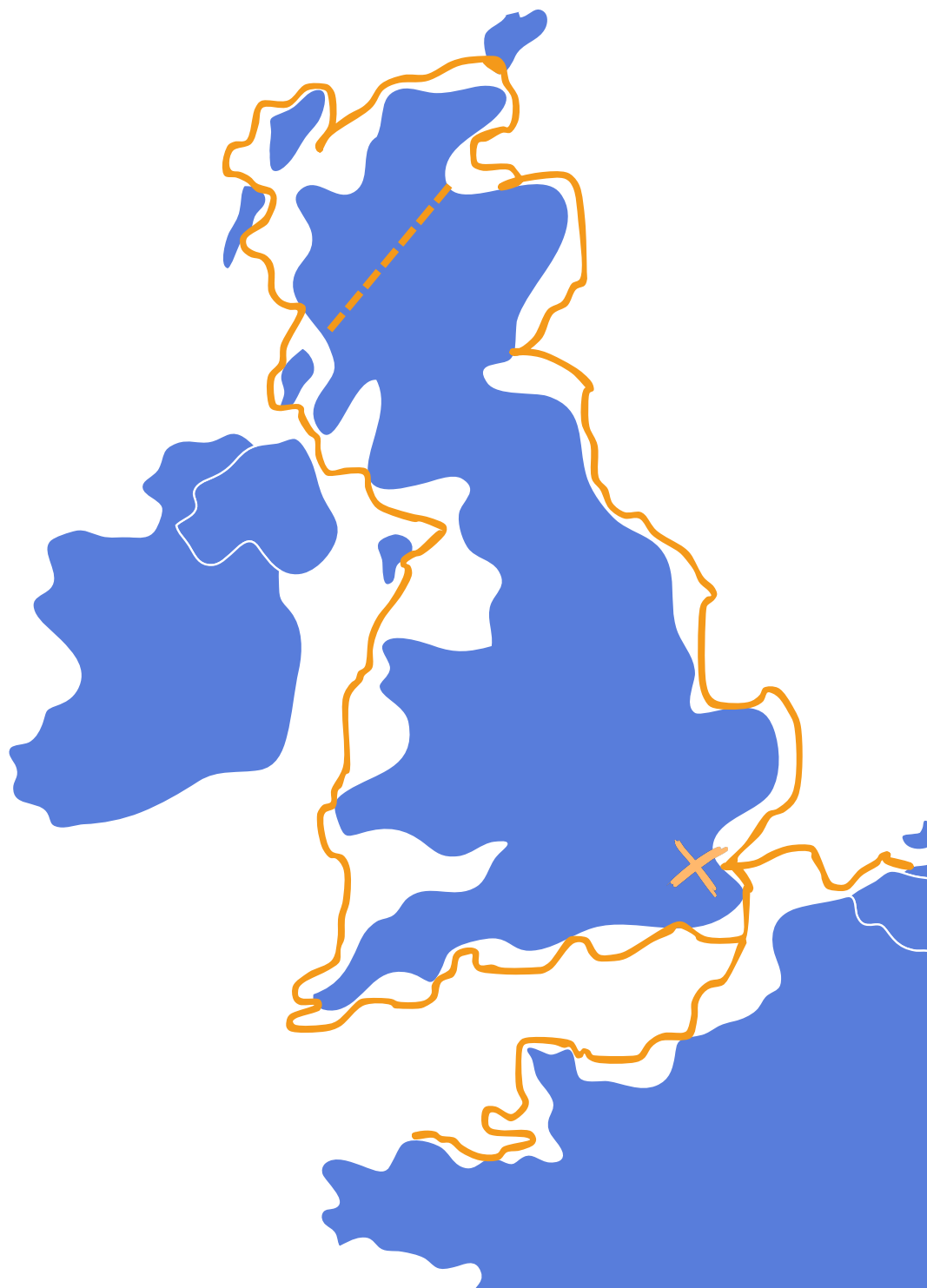

WHAT PRIOR EXPERIENCE DO YOU NEED FOR FAST TRACK YACHTMASTER?

No qualifications? No problem. To join our Fast Track program, you don't need a CV full of certificates—just a passion for life at sea and the drive to work hard.

Here is what we look for:

- **The Baseline:** A **minimum of 5 days and 100 miles logged** as crew on a sailing yacht. (If you don't have this yet, we can get you up to speed with our introductory course).
- **The Mindset:** A **team player** ready to embrace challenge, commitment, and close-quarters crew dynamics.
- **The Fitness:** **Reasonably fit and healthy.** If you plan to work commercially, you will need to pass a basic marine medical exam (ENG1 or ML5).

Already have some miles under your belt? Prior experience or qualifications are a fantastic head start. While we can sometimes fast-track you past early modules to save you time and money, we usually recommend starting from day one. Completing the full program cements a rock-solid foundation, allowing you to turn that extra experience into an even higher standard of seamanship.

2. Secure the Booking: To lock in your place before the hold expires, **submit your completed booking form along with a 25% initial deposit** (non-refundable).
3. **Flexible Payment Structure:**
 - 4 Months Before Start: A second payment of 50% of the remaining balance is due.
 - 2 Months (56 Days) Before Start: The final outstanding balance is due.

YOUR PEACE OF MIND

While we carry comprehensive marine insurance, we strongly recommend securing your own personal travel and maritime insurance. Your policy should cover personal property, illness, course cancellation, or unexpected curtailment.

To ensure you are fully protected during your training adventures with us, please verify that your policy includes the following coverage criteria:

- Activity: Valid for sailing as trainee crew on yachts.
- Navigation Limits: Coastal waters of the UK and NW Europe.
- Distance: Up to 60 miles from a safe haven.
- Duration: Individual trips up to 3 days away from a safe haven, covering cumulative trips up to 90 days within any 16-week period.

WORKING AS A YACHTMASTER: COMMERCIAL ENDORSEMENT

We can support you with you progress through commercial endorsement through our series of professional bolt-on's

To work professionally, your RYA Yachtmaster Certificate of Competence requires a Commercial Endorsement. This proves you have completed the mandatory safety training and medical fitness exams required to command commercial vessels.

1. Standard Commercial Endorsement

Ideal for the vast majority of skippers working in sailing schools, yacht charter, and delivery companies worldwide.

Requirements:

- Sea Survival: RYA Sea Survival (1 day) or STCW Personal Survival Techniques (1 day).
- PPR Course: Professional Practices and Responsibilities online module (enrolment fee included in your Fast Track course). This can be booked and completed through Elite Sailing.
- Medical Exam: A passed ML5 or ENG1 medical fitness form.

2. STCW Commercial Endorsement

Required by certain non-UK maritime authorities and essential if you want to work as crew on large superyachts and commercial vessels worldwide.

Requirements: You must complete the 4 mandatory STCW (Standards of Training and Certification for Watchkeepers) safety courses:

- Personal Survival Techniques (1 day)
- Personal Safety & Social Responsibilities (1 day)
- Elementary First Aid (1 day)
- Fire Prevention & Fire Fighting (2 days)

STCW can be booked through Elite Sailing as a bolt-on to your Fast Track course.

3. MCA Master of Yachts 200gt

Some non-UK authorities do not accept standard RYA certificates on foreign-flagged vessels. To bypass this, you can upgrade to the highly prestigious MCA Certificate of Competence (Master of Yachts 200gt).

The Process:

1. Hold a valid RYA Yachtmaster Offshore or Ocean certificate.
2. Pass an MCA Oral Examination covering maritime law, ship stability, and bridge management.
3. Recommended: Attend a 5-day oral preparation course to guarantee exam confidence. Elite Sailing can fully arrange this prep course and your MCA exam.

Note: You can commercially endorse your Yachtmaster certificate when it is first issued, or add it later via the RYA

I'd recommend it because it's a fast-paced but rewarding way to gain qualifications, practical experience, and confidence in a relatively short amount of time. **Having a smaller cohort was without a doubt one of the best things for me, compared to other companies where you have 10-15 in a cohort you wouldn't necessarily get that attention.** It also gives you a strong foundation for working in the industry and helps prepare you for real-life situations rather than just “classroom” learning where as we are put in many different environments whether that's from rivers to crossing over to Ireland to going out sailing to Ramsgate.

Right now I've completed my Yachtmaster Offshore (Sail) and Cruising Instructor qualification, I am **now working on super yachts which I have just 5 months working on a 66M out in Dubai and have now just taken my 2nd job which is out in Singapore on a 40M super yacht.** ”

FAQ's

Q: How do I book a course?

A: Simply call us on 01634 890512 or email office@elitesailing.co.uk. We will check availability and hold a provisional place for you for 5 working days pending your deposit.

Q: Can I work commercially with a Yachtmaster qualification?

A: Yes. By adding a Commercial Endorsement (which requires a basic medical exam and short safety modules), you can legally work as a professional skipper or crew worldwide.

Q: How long is the Fast Track course? A: Our comprehensive Fast Track to Yachtmaster Offshore program takes 17 weeks of intensive, continuous training to fully prepare you for the professional industry.

Q: Where will I stay during the course? A: You will live on board our modern training yachts for the practical modules, giving you true immersion in the seafaring lifestyle. During shore-based theory weeks, you will need to source your own accommodation locally (if we have space on a yacht in the marina we may allow you to sleep onboard with prior arrangement)

Q: Where is the course run and what is the training ground?

A: We are based at Chatham Maritime Marina in Kent. Your training ground is the demanding, tidal waters of the Thames Estuary and the North Sea, culminating in an epic 2,500-mile Round Britain circumnavigation.

Q: Have other people gone on to successful careers after training with Elite?

A: Absolutely. Our graduates work globally as superyacht crew, charter skippers in the Med and Caribbean, delivery captains, and RYA instructors. Training in our challenging waters gives you a major edge with employers. separately, but we handle all the scheduling and logistics for you.

FAQ's Continued...

Q: Do I need any prior sailing experience to start?

A: No prior qualifications are needed. You just need a baseline of 100 miles at sea as crew, which we can easily provide for you in an introductory week before the main course starts.

Q: What is included in the course fees?

A: Your fees cover your onboard accommodation during practical training, fuel, mooring fees, RYA logbooks, experienced instructors for all of the courses and activities outlined. Food on board is also provided during practical training blocks.

Q: What clothing or equipment do I need to bring?

A: We provide all specialist safety equipment, including lifejackets and harnesses. You will just need high-quality waterproofs, warm layers, and footwear, for which we will provide a full kit list before you arrive.

Q: I already have some experience and some of the qualifications outlined, do I need to re-do them?

A: We don't believe in a one-size-fits-all approach. We can evaluate your existing experience to adjust your course content, tailor the duration, and reduce your price with a completely bespoke training

Q: What isn't included?
